Use one payment for each registration; checks/money orders for multiple registrations will be returned. Make check or money order payable to Spirit of the Pines. Cabin assignments are made on a first come, first serve basis. Any cancellations or changes to your registration must be made by noon on October 2, 2013 or your payment will be deposited and not returned. Your registration and cabin assignment cannot be given away, exchanged, canceled or in any way changed except by direct communication with the registration secretary. Call Randy W., the registration secretary at 972-955-9822 to cancel or change your registration. Cost is \$95.00 when preregistered or \$100.00 at the door. The last day to preregister is September 25, 2013. Do not mail your registration after September 25, 2013.

NO SCHOLARSHIPS will be given on site. A VERY LIMITED AMOUNT of scholarships will be provided at a reduced price (\$25.00). Contact your nearest committee member (names/number listed above) for information about scholarships. A LETTER REQUESTING A SCHOLARSHIP MUST BE MAILED TO THE REGISTRATION SECRETARY NO LATER THAN September 25, 2013. Payment for Scholarship (\$25) must be received by September 28, 2013 and must accompany request.

A self-addressed stamped envelope must be received with payment for those requiring a confirmation or scholarship.

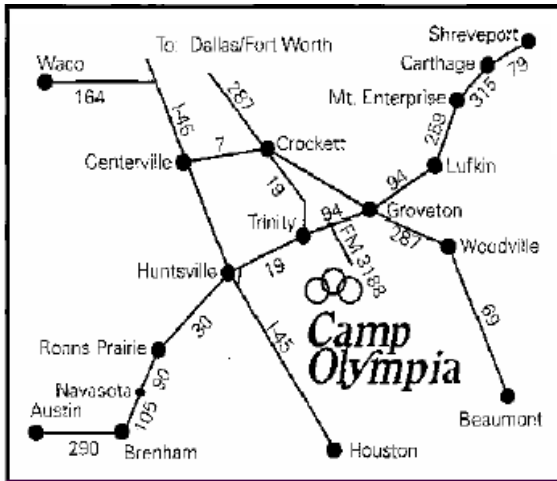

Donations for scholarships will be appreciated. **Scholarship applicants must include a self addressed stamped envelope along with the \$25.00 Scholarship preregistration.**

**ACCOMMODATIONS:** Sleeping accommodations are dormitory bunk-bed style. Men's and women's cabins are separate. There are no coeducational sleeping quarters. There are a total of 12 cabins for men and 12 cabins for women. Bring your own towels, personal hygiene articles, blanket, sleeping bag, pillow, swimsuit, sports items, books, rain gear, and TEDDY BEARS. Consider the changeable Texas weather and be sure bedding and clothing are appropriate for variable weekend weather. **PLEASE BRING A FLASHLIGHT.** The camp covers a large area. **In case of emergency, Camp Olympia's phone number is 936-594-2541.**

**Directions To Camp Olympia:**



**Houston:** From I-45 North take exit 113, which is Hwy 19. Stay on Hwy 19 about 20 miles to Trinity, turning right at the second red light onto Hwy 94. Go 3 miles and turn right on FM 3188. Follow the road about 5 miles to the gates of Camp Olympia.

**Dallas:** From I-45 South, exit Hwy 7 at Centerville. Go east to Crockett. In Crockett, go right on Loop 304 for about 1 mile. Turn right on Hwy 19 and travel south to Trinity. In Trinity, turn left at the first red light onto Hwy 94. Go 3 miles and turn right on FM 3188. Follow the road about 5 miles to the gates of Camp Olympia.

**Beaumont:** From Beaumont, take Hwy 69 North to Woodville. Take Hwy 287 northwest to Groveton. In Groveton, turn left on Hwy 94 and travel 15 miles southwest. Turn left on FM 3188. Follow the road about 5 miles to the gates of Camp Olympia.

**Recreational Facilities:** Ropes course, swimming and canoeing will occur on Saturday afternoon and are included in the price of registration.

**Cost of Retreat:** \$95.00 per adult or child for preregistered or \$100.00 at the door (includes 5 meals and 2 night accommodations). Your badge is considered your meal ticket and must be worn to the dining room. Off-Site Lodging: \$30.00 registration, \$6.00 each meal. Meal tickets can be purchased during registration times. **No on-site Camping or Tents are allowed at Camp Olympia. Also, Camp Olympia is a non-smoking facility. Smoking is not permitted anywhere on the grounds.**

**Priority Cabin Assignment:** Preregistrants are assigned cabin space on a first come, first serve basis. **To receive confirmation of your registration or scholarship, send a self-addressed stamped envelope. You must send in your check or money order with your registration slip to be considered for priority cabin assignment.** Note: If you do not cancel your reservation by noon on October 2, 2013, your check or money order will be deposited, not returned. **Call Randy W. at 972-955-9822 by noon October 2, 2013 and your payment will be returned or destroyed as instructed.**

**Selecting a Cabin:** Maximum bed capacity at Camp Olympia is 464. Cabin assignment will be made on a first come, first serve basis. The cabins for both men and women are fairly close to the meeting area. You may drive to the cabins to unload or load your belongings. **Women should not loiter around the Men's Cabin areas and Men should not loiter around the Women's Cabin areas.**

**Parking is allowed ONLY on the entrance road by the Chow Hall.**

**Women's Cabins:** The cabins are numbered 1 through 12. Cabin #1 is closest to the meeting area.

Cabins #11 and #12 are the Quiet Cabins.

**Men's Cabins:** The cabins are number 1 through 12. Cabin #1 is closest to the meeting area.

Cabin #12 is the Quiet Cabin.

**Note: The Hera and Artemis Cabins are for handicapped individuals only.**

**Program:** Registration begins at 4:00 p.m. on Friday October 4, 2013 and ends at **10:00 p.m.** Registration continues on Saturday until 1:00 p.m. The first meeting is 5:30 p.m. Friday night. Dinner will be served at 6:45 p.m. Meeting schedules for the weekend will be available at the registration desk and online.

**Important: Assumption of Risk Form must be turned in at time of arrival for ALL participants, chaperones, special guests, etc.** Failure to do so voids the contract and cancels the group's stay. Anyone not having a form signed will not be allowed to participate. **No pets** will be allowed at Spirit of the Pines.
